In this regard our organization RDO - Rural Development Organization has been initiated by the year of 1999 in Pudukkottai District, Tamilnadu with an ambition of empowering the poor, downtrodden people to attain their basic livelihood rights of social equality, educationally literates, economically self sustained, communally independent, politically participative and access to all health

services for their pleasurable survival. To ensure this, our organization has been functioning in various developmental programs for the past 24 years.

We are the legally registered NGO, serving the needy by having collaboration with Government Bodies, Corporates, donor agencies and sponsors. We are mainly into the service of "Identify, Rescue and Rehabilitate the victims" by following the rules and Law of Government. We are...

TARGET POPULATION:

Our target population are the most vulnerable of our community those are still struggling fortheir rights and survival especially women, children, aged, widows, destitute, sex workers, the people those are living with HIV/AIDS, street dwellers and the people those are affected and or infected by panic and or pandemic diseases and natural disaster etc,.

WORKING AREAS:

We are servicing in Pudukkottai, Cuddalore & Sivaganga district of Tamilnadu. But whenever & wherever we felt needed we are able to extend our works at any districts of our state.

MAJOR PROGRAMS:

Our organization has been enhanced and implemented various developmental activities/ programmes. During this reporting period of 2022-2023, we have enhanced the following programs...

Those are...

- **Tamilnadu Skill Development Corporation,** Govt. of Tamilnadu To give Skill Development Training for Unemployed Youth & Refugees.
- **DSWO** District Social welfare Office, Govt. of Tamilnadu Skill Development Training for rescued victims of Child marriage, poor girls from covid-19 affected family and dropout children.
- **Childline 1098** (Helpline for children, under the Ministry of Women & Child Development, Govt. of India)
- Local & International volunteers: Offered Sewing Machine for the foremost poor beneficiaries.
- **DIZ(German NGO)** : Voluneership Program for Cultural Exchange
- **Backward & Minority Welfare Department: Govt. Of Tamilnadu** To give Skill Development Training for the beneficiaries from minority community.
- **ARKEMA** (Corporate) To provide skill Development education to unemployed youth at Cuddalore.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING for UNEMPLOYED YOUTH & REFUGEES:



We are supporting the unemployed youth & Srilankan refugees of Pudukkottai District by providing the Skill Development Training in Tailoring with the support of "Tamilnadu

Skill Development Corporation", **Government of Tamilnadu**. It is the certified course, providing four months of severe training, after the completion of successful Training, there

will be assessment of the project and then they get into the exam, once they pass it over, they will be honored with certificate.

For refugees - we had given the training in three places called Thoppukollai, Aliyanilai and Thekkattur Srilankan refugees' camps in Pudukkottai District.

All the 90 beneficiaries have completed their training successfully and succeeded in their exams and got their certificate. We have arranged the employment opportunities for them. 56% of the trainees got placement in private sectors and local mart. 20% of the beneficiaries have started their own self business

and few of them started business as joint venture. For Unemployed youth, we had given training in the following places of Arimalam & Pudukkottai at Pudukkottai District.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING -VICTIMS:

Our organization is also given training to for the victims of Child marriage & poor girls from covid-19 affected family and dropout children with the support of **DSWO**- District Social Welfare Office, Govt. of Tamilnadu. Through



this, Batch1- 44 victims and Batch2- 14 Victims had been benefitted.

For those who have completed training in all categories, we have conducted the

Job Fair at District Skill Development Offi that Job Fair, four private sectors from Chennai, Trichy, Thiruppur & Pudukkottai had participated and recruited the

candidates for their companies. The International Company called "TRIUMPH" was also one of the participant. Through this job fair, many of our beneficiaries got placement and others also got placed.



DIZ(German NGO):

DIZ-Deutsch-Indische Zusammenarbeit e.V. is an German NGO sending and receiving volunteers from across the world for the concept of Cultural Exchange by having collaboration with BMZ-German Government.

For this volunteership Program, we have received two volunteers named **Caroline Molzeberger** – duration 20.12.2022- 07.06.2023 and **Caroline**



Lenuneberger – duration 20.12.2022-04.07.2023 from Germany at contractual basis. During this period, they work for RDO and support our projects and serve for the poor, also they learn our working module and technologies. According to volunteers' capabilities, they work in relevant field.

Backward & Minority Welfare Department:



We have given Skill Development Training for the beneficiaries from minority community through **Backward & Minority Welfare Department, Govt. of**

Tamilnadu. 20 beneficiaries[Muslims-15, Chritians-5] are benefitted out of this scheme at MirattunilaiPanchayat in Pudukkottai District from June 2022-December2022.

All of them are completed their training successfully and got their certificates. We have Created the sustainable

livelihood opportunities for this beneficiaries. Now, they have started to generate income out of it.



SEWING MACHINE OFFERED:



We have selected the foremost poor beneficiaries from the trainees and offered "Sewing Machine" to start up their own business with the support of local and international volunteers.

International volunteer has supported us to give Sewing Machine for 10 beneficiaries at 15.10.22



and we have issued 2 more beneficiaries with the support of local volunteer. Still we are working on and keep approaching the volunteers and donors to help other beneficiaries.

ARKEMA (Corporate):

The corporate company called ARKEMA had supported us to give Vocational Training in Tailoring at Cuddalore district for the deprived and poor girls and women, destitute, widows and the girls from victim's (Covid-19) family.

Through this project we have supported poor beneficiaries. Now this project has been Strengthen to run the centre by our trainees by the concept of making self Entrepreneurs. Machineries had been supported by VIBHA.



CHILDLINE 1098 PROGRAM:

We have been servicing as the partner of Childline1098 program, since 2011. With the guidance and financial, technical support of the Ministry of Women and Child Development, Govt. of India through the autonomous body of Childline India Foundation.



We rescue the children from child marriage,

child labour, bonded labour, beggaring, child trafficking, child servitude, sexual harassments, sexual abuse, forced for illegal activities of stealing, selling drugs and pick pocketing etc,. To eradicate these evils and secure the children we have enhancing the Childline 1098 program in on most effective and progress manner inThiruvarankulam, Thirumayam,

Arimalam and Ponnamaravathi blocks of Pudukkottai district.

Our team members are having been established close and favorable rapport with the Government departments such as, the Police, District social welfare, District child protection unit, child welfare committee labour, education, health, Juvenile Justice Board, Revenue and ICDS departments and along with the public welfare activist groups of Lion & Rotary clubs, Youth clubs and women SHGs etc., to rescue the distress children and extended needed rehabilitation services.



During this reporting period we have enhanced various interventions and rescued 164 nos. of children from various distress situations.

In this regard during this reporting period we have received totally 113 nos. of cases through 1098 and through outreach program we have found and identified 51 Nos. of cases and net total 164 nos. of cases have registered and intervened.



Programmes conducted:

Conducted 6nos. of open house programs (On 27.07.22 –Pichakalampatti in Ponnamaravathi block, on 11.08.22 & 12.08.22 – Thulaiyanur & Adhanur in Thirumayam block, on 26.08.22 – Mettuppatti in

Thiruvarankulam block, on 14.10.22 – Kadiyapatti in Arimalam block, on 31.03.22 – Onangudi in Arimalam block) during the period Apr'22 – Mar'23. Through these programs we have established good rapport with general public and awareness created sensitively about Childline1098. Through by these open house programs the school children were exposed their needs not only on school based but also their village based existing problems towards the public.

This kind of open house program has assisted the children's skills to expose their needs in onappreciable and honorable manner

- We have contacted 12 Self Help Group's members awareness trainings about Childline1098& child rights and Corona virus, HIV/AIDS infection and its effects
- Conducted 37nos. of Anganwadi awareness, 14 nos. of adolescent groups & 14 nos. of children's groups' awareness programs in our service areas. In which clear awareness had given about Childline1098 & its activities and also about child rights & protection.





 We have given 149nos. (Primary& Middle school: 127, High school: 13 & Higher secondary school: 9, Total nos. of students reached : 12590) of



awareness programs to Primary to Higher Sec. school level students about Good touch, bad touch & No touch, child sexual abuse, POCSO Act, Child Marriage prevention Act and we have conducted 21 nos. of awareness programs for Panchayatraj members and staff and we have given 54 awareness trainings to MGNREGS workers at their work places (Children: 520, Adult: 2430) about child sexual abuse, POCSO Act, Child Marriage prevention Act and Corona virus, importance of

vaccination, HIV/AIDS infection and its effects. We have provided basic knowledge to the MGNREGS workers on, in what critical situation the children are abused especially most of the child abuse were enhanced by close relative, friends and the neighbors of the families.

- We have conducted 32 streets, 5 nos. of bus stands, 3 nos. of Auto & taxi stands, 33 nos. of police stations, 3 nos. of slum areas, 3 nos. of hospitals, 23 nos. of anganwadi and 6 nos. of mass outreach programs in temple festival seasons.
- Conducted 3 nos of Taluk Advisory Board -TAB meetings at Thirumayam Taluk on 30.08.22 and Ponnamaravathi Taluk on 07.09.22, Alangudi Taluk on 20.09.22 under the Presidentship of concern Tahsildhar. Totally 3 TAB meetings were conducted. We have discussed Taluk level child related issues and resolutions made to solve those existing problems. Taluk level Government officials, club members & allied departments were participated. Clear awareness had given among those about Childline1098 & its activities.
